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New Submissions Policy

As of 2007, due to significant increases in volume, Lerner Publishing Group no longer accepts unsolicited submissions in any of our imprints.

We will continue to seek targeted solicitations at specific reading levels and in specific subject areas. The company will list these targeted solicitations on our website and in national newsletters, such as the SCBWI Bulletin.

To enhance the marketability of your manuscript, you may wish to consider several options:

- Join a group that will help you learn about children's publishing, such as the SCBWI [<http://www.scbwi.org>].
- Form or join a critique group that focuses on constructive critiques.
- Find an agent who can help to place your manuscript with the right publisher. Some agents also collaborate with authors on revisions to improve a manuscript. We recommend looking for an agent who is a member of the Association of Artists Representatives (AAR) [<http://www.aar-online.org>].
- Work with an editorial service to improve the quality of your manuscript before submitting it. Lerner Publishing Group recommends The Queue [www.queuebooks.com] for such services, as this company has special expertise in vetting children's book manuscripts.
